We are pleased to announce that UnitedHealthcare[®] has been approved by the State of Wisconsin Group Insurance Board to replace your current Medicare Plus plan administered by WEA Trust. The UnitedHealthcare Medicare Plus plan offers coverage beginning January 1, 2023.

The UnitedHealthcare Medicare Plus plan will offer:

- 1. The same benefits as your current plan like paying your Medicare Part A and B deductibles and coinsurance.
- 2. You may continue to see any doctor anywhere in the 50 United States, the District of Columbia and the U.S. territories. The Medicare Plus plan will also provide protection against billed charges that exceed the Medicare approved amount. In addition, the Medicare Plus plan will provide coverage for services received when you're outside of the United States that would typically be covered by Medicare.
- 3. You will also be eligible to participate in a free gym membership through Renew Active.
 - Renew Active[®] is a fitness program that focuses on both body and mind at no additional cost to you.
 - Stay fit with a free gym membership at a fitness location you select from Renew Active's nationwide network, which includes many premium gyms. If you prefer to exercise at home, you can view thousands of on-demand workout videos and live streaming fitness classes.
 - Stay connected socially through local health and wellness classes and events.
 Also, connect socially by joining the online Fitbit[®] Community for Renew Active.
 No Fitbit device is needed.
 - Stay focused on brain health with AARP® Staying Sharp®, an online brain health program including exclusive content for Renew Active members.

If you want to continue your current coverage in the Medicare Plus plan **you must enroll in the new Medicare Plus plan with UnitedHealthcare**® during open enrollment. The 2023 Health Benefits Decision Guide and a Group Health Insurance Application/Change for Retirees & COBRA Continuants (ET-2331) will be mailed to you in mid-September.

If you are a State of Wisconsin retiree, note that the Medicare Family All rates printed in your Decision Guide on page 16 are in error. They are too high. The Medicare Family All rate should read as \$771.00 with dental and \$708.68 without dental. The most up-to-date information and corrected rates appear at etf.wi.gov.

You have many health plan options to choose from. You *must enroll in a new plan* during open enrollment. The annual open enrollment period will take place between September 26 and October 21, 2022. *If you do not select a plan by October 21, 2022, you will not have coverage as of January 1, 2023.*
