Get to know the UnitedHealthcare Group Medicare Advantage plan

We have worked closely with The Board of Pensions of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) to design your plan and offer these benefits. This flyer includes some of the ways benefits may be changing. We recommend reviewing this with your provider to help get the most from your benefits.

In 2027, you will get two member ID cards – one for your Medicare Advantage plan and one for your Medicare Part D prescription drug plan. Use your **Medicare Advantage member ID card** for medical benefits and Part B-covered supplies. Use your **Medicare Part D member ID card** for prescription drug benefits. Take both cards to provider appointments and the pharmacy so you have the correct coverage information when needed.

UnitedHealthcare Medicare Part B coverage

Medicare Part B eligible drugs will be covered under the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage plan rather than the Medicare Part D plan. These are some of the most commonly prescribed Part B eligible products:

- Diabetes testing supplies such as glucose meter supplies and continuous glucose monitors (CGMs)
- HIV prevention drugs
- Vaccines such as flu, pneumonia and hepatitis B (shingles vaccine is covered under Part D)
- Immunosuppressant drugs for transplant patients
- Drugs used with a nebulizer at home
- Oral anti-cancer drugs

When filling or refilling a Medicare Part B eligible product, take the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage member ID card to the pharmacy so they can bill the Medicare Advantage plan.

Coverage for diabetes supplies

A blood glucose meter and test strips will also be covered under the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage plan.

If needed, get a new meter for \$0.

To have a blood glucose meter and strips covered in 2027, a member must use one of the following Contour® or Accu-Chek® meters. These covered meters and strips will have a \$0 copay.

- CONTOUR® Plus Blue, Next Gen, Next One and Next EZ Meters with CONTOUR® Plus and Next test strips
- Accu-Chek® Guide Me and Guide meters with Accu-Chek® Guide test strips

If you get a new prescription for a meter and strips, it can be filled at an in-network pharmacy or durable medical equipment (DME) supplier with the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage member ID card.

Other monitoring systems and diabetes technologies.

- Insulin pumps and pump supplies are covered under Medicare Part B and can be filled at an in-network durable medical equipment (DME) supplier with the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage member ID card.
- Continuous glucose monitors (CGM) are covered under Medicare Part B and can be filled at an in-network pharmacy or DME supplier with the UnitedHealthcare Medicare Advantage member ID card.
- Other insulin delivery systems, such as Omnipods, may be covered under Medicare Part D and can be filled at an in-network pharmacy or DME supplier with the Medicare Part D member ID card.
