

Choose an authorized representative



An authorized representative is a person you choose to help you with your health plan.

You can name a spouse, caregiver or someone else you trust as your authorized representative. A caregiver may be a family member, friend, or neighbor who provides assistance with the activities of daily living and/or medical tasks.

Your authorized representative can speak with us about your account, including your personal health information, monthly premium, plan benefits, claims and other questions you have.
